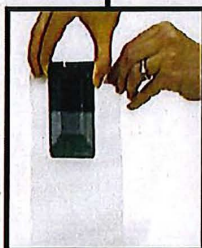

## How to package your batteries for mailing.



### 1 SECURE IT.

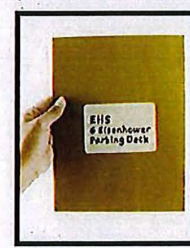
Place one battery into a bag, or tape each battery with clear tape.

**Do not put more than one battery into a bag.**



### 2 SEAL IT.

After bagging or taping each battery, place the battery into the preaddressed mailing envelope.



### 3 MAIL IT.

Deposit envelope into campus mail to Environmental Health and Safety for recycling.

**Do you have a battery that does not fit into a mailer?**

Place clear packaging tape over the battery terminals.
